Ali Pieken, current Parks Commission member and fundraising powerhouse, has requested that on September 29, 2024, that the City close a portion of Indian Trail Drive from 4:00 P.M. to 9:00 P.M. for Church Worship Night. The event will begin at 5:00 P.M. Church Worship Night is hosted her by church and other local churches. Each church will be playing a set of worship music for the public to come and enjoy. Last time they did this event there were tons of kids and they were constantly running back and forth from mom and dad and Kiddie Coral playground. It made me quite nervous with them running across that strip of road there. Between the strip of road and cars parked along there adding blind spots, there are legitimate safety concerns for children. Closure of the road will help prevent any potential accidents.

City Administrator Recommends Approval

7. Presentation for SHIFT ATL on 201 West 14th Street Reimbursement to the City's Housing Development Fund.

SHIFT ATL has reimbursed the City for their \$100,000.00 loan to rehabilitate 201 West 14th Street.

First Ward Councilwoman, Emily Kennedy will comment on the success of this project and the ongoing efforts at housing rehabilitation in Atlantic.

8. Resolution #50-24 "Appointing Laura McLean as the Atlantic City Clerk and Setting Compensation for FY 2025."

Former City Clerk Barb Barrick had her last day with the City on March 22, 2024. This is a critical office of the City, one that is required by Iowa Statute to remain incorporated as a municipal entity.

The Personnel & Finance Committee has recommended that Laura McLean be the next City Clerk. Personnel & Finance Chairwoman Elaine Otte had the following to say regarding the process and selection of the new City Clerk.

"We are pleased to announce that Laura McLean has been selected to fill the position of City Clerk for the City of Atlantic after a multitiered interview process. Throughout the process Laura made it clear she would always strive to do what is best for the city, it citizens and our employees. She brings a strong set of education, skills and experience and is excited to join our team.

Also, we would like to thank all the candidates who applied and interviewed for the position."

City Administrator Does Not Comment on Political Appointments

9. Third and Final Reading of Ordinance No. 1045 "Vacating the 66' Wide Street Right-of-Way of West Fourth Street in the City of Atlantic, Iowa Described as Follows: Beginning at the West Right-of-Way Line of Laurel Street Extended, Thence West to the East Property Line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad. Said Parcel Containing Approximately 0.7 Acres. Said Described Real Estate is Subject to a Stormwater Sewer Easement Reserved unto and Held by the City of Atlantic, Iowa."

The City Council held the public hearing and passed the first reading of Ordinance No. 1045 during the August 21st City Council meeting. The second reading was passed during the September 4, 2024 Council meeting. The following information is from those notes.


"During the May 1, 2024 City Council meeting, the Council referred the request by Rob Stamp for the City to vacate a phantom street Right-of-Way (ROW) that begins at the corner of West 4th Street and Laurel Street, going Westbound and terminating at the Phantom Railroad ROW, to the Planning & Zoning Commission for their review and technical recommendation.

Mr. Stamp desires additional access to his property to the north, to do this he wishes cut the curb on the vacated area and pour a driveway and maintain it as

another entrance. The approximate area of the entrance is indicated in blue, below.



Once the referral of the ROW vacating is made to the Commission, the Commission must meet and send their recommendation back to the Council within 30 days.



The following statements were gathered by various experts regarding business and infrastructure.

City Engineer Dave Sturm recommends that Mr. Stamp simply be allowed to build a driveway to his property on the Street Right-of-Way, after getting permission from the City Council and getting protective rights to his improvements. He recommends this because there is stormwater infrastructure on the north side of West 4th Street (seen in

Red) and drainage runoff (Purple) in the proposed ROW. Alternatively, he recommended that the City get a stormwater utility easement as part of the vacating process.

From an Economic Development Perspective, Cass-Atlantic Development Corporation (CADCO) Executive Director, Jen McEntaffer had the following quote for the Commission: "The railroad spur has been vacant for an extended period and the likelihood that the Iowa Interstate Railroad would put back in operation is highly unlikely. The price of the railroad spur would be cost prohibitive. I see no economic development purpose in maintaining the ROW."

Executive Director of Atlantic Municipal Utilities (AMU), Steve Tjepkes stated that no water or electric infrastructure existed within the ROW.

City of Atlantic Public Works Director Kirk Knudsen stated that the from his perspective, this ROW has no current or future value to the City.

It is up to the Commission to determine what the best course of action is and I will report that to the City Council, tomorrow night.

The Planning & Zoning Commission reviewed the issue and unanimously recommends the City vacate the property. The City Council met on May 15, 2024 and formally decided to accept the proposal to vacate the property from the Planning & Zoning Commission and referred the matter to the City Attorney for legal preparation. The vacating process is ready to begin.

The process of vacating City ROW is entirely dictated by Iowa Code, specifically Sections: 364.12(2)(a), 392.1, 364.15, 364.7, 174.15(2), and 364.7(3)."

City Administrator Recommends Approval

The Board of Adjustment reviews appeals of the zoning and sign ordinances. A property owner may request an appeal due to special exceptions, differences in interpretation, or requirements that create a hardship for the property owner. The Board meets as needed on the second Monday of the month at 7:30 a.m. The five Board Members are appointed by the Mayor and serve three year staggered terms.

The Mayor has chosen to renominate Shawn Shouse to another Term on the Board of Adjustment.

Tammy DeBord, Grant Specialist 3 with the Southwest Iowa Planning Council (SWIPCO) has submitted the SIWPCO administration invoices 1 and 2 for the Atlantic-Atlantic Municipal Utilities (AMU) Water Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). She has stated the Council should approve and pay these, and then will be reimbursed by the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA). This is a pass-through expenditure. 'Prohibited Trees: Freeman/Hybrid Maple (*Acer x freemanii* Autumn Blaze, Armstrong, Marmo, and Sienna Glen are frequently seen cultivars), Amur Maple, Norway Maple, Ash, Blue Spruce, Callery/Ornamental Pear, Ornamental Cherry, Mulberry, Golden Raintree, Tree of Heaven, Black Locust, White Poplar, Siberian Elm, Russian Olive & Salt Cedar.'"

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THE 66' WIDE STREET RIGHT-OF-WAY OF WEST FOURTH STREET IN THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS: BEGINNING AT THE WEST RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF LAUREL STREET EXTENDED, THENCE WEST TO THE EAST PROPERTY LINE OF THE IOWA INTERSTATE RAILROAD. SAID PARCEL CONTAINING APPROXIMATELY 0.7 ACRES. SAID DESCRIBED REAL ESTATE IS SUBJECT TO A STORMWATER SEWER EASEMENT RESERVED UNTO AND HELD BY THE CITY OF ATLANTIC, IOWA.

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published in the manner required by law, on the 17th day of August, 2024, this Council held a public hearing on a proposal to vacate a certain portion of the right of way as hereinafter described; and

WHEREAS, this Council determines that it is in the best interests of the City that said right of way be vacated.

BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Atlantic, Iowa:

SECTION 1. The City of Atlantic, Iowa does hereby vacate and release the following-described right of way:

The 66' wide street right-of-way of West Fourth Street described as follows: Beginning at the west right-of-way line of Laurel Street extended, thence west to the east property line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad. Said parcel containing approximately 0.7 acres. Said described real estate is subject to a stormwater sewer easement reserved unto and held by the City of Atlantic, Iowa.

SECTION 2. The vacated right of way is hereby conveyed, as follows:

A. The North Half of that portion of the vacated right of way running East and West legally described as the 66' wide street right-of-way of West Fourth Street described as follows: Beginning at the west right-of-way line of Laurel Street extended, thence west to the east property line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad. Said parcel containing approximately 0.7 acres.

Title thereto is quieted to Romar Investments, LLC.

B. The South Half of that portion of the vacated right of way running East and West legally described as the 66' wide street right-of-way of West Fourth Street described as follows: Beginning at the west right-of-way line of Laurel Street extended, thence west to the east property line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad. Said parcel containing approximately 0.7 acres; EXCEPT that portion of the South Half that is adjacent to and North of Block 93 of the Original Town.

Title thereto is quieted to Kevin K. Archibald and Bonnie L. Archibald, as joint tenants with full rights of survivorship and not as tenants in common.

C. The South Half of that portion of the vacated right of way running East and West legally described as the 66' wide street right-of-way of West Fourth Street described as follows: Beginning at the west right-of-way line of Laurel Street extended, thence west to the east property line of the Iowa Interstate Railroad. Said parcel containing approximately 0.7 acres, which is adjacent to and North of Block 93 of the Original Town.

Title thereto is quieted to Kevin L. Denison.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision, or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. WHEN EFFECTIVE. This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

Wastewater Operation & Maintenance

Camblin Mechanical came back, and treated heat pumps 1&2 and they are working fine.

The lining project by Atlantic Carriers only took one looong day. They completed it after midnight and through the storm. The Public Works dept came in later and leveled out a small area that was left due to the wet condition at that time.

Councilperson Shawn Sarsfield Ward came out for a tour. The staff was out on the collection system, but we were able to go through the plant. The city has a very good facility and we are always happy to walk people through it.

Staff got through a large number of lines and will be back at it later after hauling.

We are in the fields hauling solids and will be working with the farmer on a new plan.

Took in 335,738.8 gallons of leachate which represents additional income of nearly \$20,000. By us being able to accept this it saves the county/ county tax payers a bunch over having to haul to Corning.
